





## MAL STUDIO DAYS - CALL FOR STUDIO ARTIST/HOSTS

Following **Board** approval, plans are in the works to **OPEN THE STUDIO/GALLERY** regularly beginning on MAY 2, 2024!

On Thursdays & Fridays from 11 - 7, and Saturdays & Sundays from 11 - 3 you can come to the **Studio** and work on your own projects, joining others who are working on their own projects. To defray the cost of having the **Studio** open, a \$5 fee will be collected each day you attend. Now and then, during those days, special **CAFÉ** (**Creative Arts for Everyone**) classes will be scheduled. We will encourage the public to visit as well.

We are hoping **ALL MAL MEMBERS** will sign up to be **STUDIO ARTIST/HOSTS!** Hosts will work 4-hour shifts. (No \$5.00 daily fee for Hosts the day they work.) This change to the Policies was voted on and accepted by the membership at the September 14, 2023 meeting. In addition to a ribbon, the awards are:

First Place: \$100 value of cash and/or merchandise Second Place: \$50 value of cash and/or merchandise Third Place: \$25 value of cash and/or merchandise

Three Honorable Mentions: no monetary award, just bragging rights

First, Second, and Third People's Choice awards: no monetary award, just bragging rights

- Angie Brandon's signature artistic name is Angie Candell, and her favorite medium is acrylic painting.
- **Jim Daugherty's** preferred media are acrylic and collage. Jim is willing to help **MAL** in the areas of **Fall Exhibit, Spring Exhibit, Peter's Library Exhibit, and as Historian**.
- Judé (Joo-day) Ernest is known for her handmade textiles, 2D & 3D art, and garments made from unspun wool, silk, and other sustainable materials. A member of the Pittsburgh Fiber Arts Guild, Washington Spinners and Weavers, and Upper St. Clair League for the Arts, she teaches adult art classes and workshops. She is Resident Artist at the Mt. Lebanon Public Library and Upper St. Clair Library. Judé is interested in helping MAL in the areas of Hospitality, Spring Exhibit, and Studio Exhibit.
- **Donna Guillen** works in several media, including acrylic, mixed media, pastel, pottery, wood carving, and watercolor.
- Dennis Moran is the retired Founder and Principal Designer of Dennis Moran Design and a
  printmaker. He is a graduate of Carnegie Mellon University with a BFA in Graphic Design, a
  Fellow of AIGA (American Institute of Graphic Arts, the Professional Association for Design),
  and was an Adjunct Professor at Carnegie Mellon University from 1988-1995. He is willing to
  help MAL in the areas of Fall Exhibit, Programs, and Studio Exhibit.

## **NOMINATIONS:**

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Now is the time to become a member of **MAL's committees!** Exciting new initiatives which are part of **MAL's "Reboot"** will help to keep our studio open daily. Instead of one or two people wearing many hats, all the time, more members can do something to make this happen! Get started in any of these positions:

- **Class Coordinator:** Obtains and schedules instructors for **MAL classes.** Three instructors have agreed to teach for **MAL** next year, so this task is part of the way completed! (Many thanks to Betty Roseborough who currently wears too many "hats").
- **Class Registrar:** Receives checks for classes and records those payments on the website, then mails the checks to the **Treasurer.**
- **Meeting Presentation Coordinator:** Obtains speakers for meetings, which are often also the upcoming instructor! Works with the **Class Coordinator**.
- Exhibitions Chair: is Betty Roseborough, who oversees and recruits all external MAL
  exhibitions excluding the Fall Show, Spring Show, Peters Library Exhibition and MAL
  studio exhibits.

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- **Fall Show Committee Chairs:** Two people are responsible for organizing and either completing or overseeing the following tasks:
  - (1) Schedule show venue and times
  - (2) Obtain registrations from the **MAL** website to print tags for paintings and to print programs,
  - (3) Scheduling MAL members to sit and take sales during open show hours,
  - (4) Organizing the "show box" and "show binder" with information for the upcoming exhibition,
  - (5) Scheduling people to deliver screens and supplies to venue, to set up, and hang the show.
  - (6) Coordinating with Standards committee to receive works on day of set-up,
  - (7) Coordinating with **Hospitality** on show reception
  - (8) Delivering sales cash, show binder, and receipts to treasurer,
  - (9) Scheduling people to take down show and return screens and supplies to studio.
- **Spring Show Committee Chairs**: Two people are responsible for organizing and either completing or overseeing the following tasks:
  - (1) Schedule show venue and times
  - (2) Contact **Corresponding Secretary** with show dates so **Secretary** can obtain awards,
  - (3) Determining type and amounts of awards,
  - (4) Find a juror for the show,
  - (5) Obtain registrations from the **MAL website** to print tags for paintings and to print programs,
  - (6) Scheduling MAL members to sit and take sales during open show hours,
  - (7) Organizing the "show box" and "show binder" with information for the upcoming exhibition,
  - (8) Scheduling people to deliver screens and supplies to venue , to set up, and hang the show,
  - (9) Coordinating with **Standards committee** to receive works on day of set-up,
  - (10) Delivering sales cash, show binder, and receipts to treasurer,
  - (11) Scheduling people to take down show and return screens and supplies to **MAL Studio.**
- Historian: Keeps a record of MAL activities, formerly done through scrapbooking but now
  can be done digitally. Saves copies of MAL newsletters, show programs, MAL activity images
  from easy-to-take-and-save phone screen shots that can be obtained from members. This
  position is usually associated with the Newsletter Editor.

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- Hospitality Co-Chairs: Two people will share the duties of providing or scheduling members
  to provide refreshments for upcoming meetings and shows and will keep track of Studio
  supplies (paper towels, water, trash bags).
- Programs Chairperson: To keep our Studio open and active on non-class/non-meeting
  days, the Programs Chairperson will oversee the scheduling of the following non-class/nonmeeting activities: Art Talks, CAFÉ, outside "field trips" for MAL members to museums, art
  show openings etc.
  - o Programs Subcommittees:
    - Art Talks obtains an MAL member to lead a discussion (with optional laptop aided presentation) about a famous artist. These are scheduled periodically on Sunday afternoons from 3:00 P.M.-5:00 P.M.
    - CAFÉ (Creative Arts for Everyone) finds MAL members who will share an activity (origami, collage, etc.), a video, or interesting book (think art "book club") to share with MAL members on a non-class day.
    - Anyone can suggest a field trip to the programs chairperson, but the suggester will be in charge of organizing scheduling, transportation and obtaining of fees, if any from interested members.
- Publicity Co-Chairs: Posts information on MAL to social media and contacts local news outlets regarding upcoming MAL events. Shares relevant images and information with Historian and Newsletter chairs.
- **Retail Sales:** (2 people) Maintain the inventory list and product placement and display of items for sale. Provides **Treasurer** with retail sales data. Is able to work with charge card reader and train **Studio Hosts** in its use and the sales process
- Studio Manager: Works with Class Coordinator, Meetings Presenter, and Programs
   Chairperson to develop monthly upcoming schedule for Studio use. Primarily oversees
   Studio sitting and usage schedule during non-activity times and oversees maintenance of
   Studio space.
- **Studio Exhibition:** Two people needed. Works with current **Committee Chair** Lisa Markowski to organize and hang themed shows in the **MAL Studio** space.


some simple designs. More information coming on other supplies that will be made available or you can bring if you already own.
