



McMurray Art League Current Policies

1. McMurray Art League (“the League”) Classes
 - a. Board Members and Committee Chairs will no longer receive a discount for each class due to rising costs. ~~receive a 10% discount for each class attended.~~
 - b. The class monitor will receive a 10% ~~25%~~ discount for each class monitored.
~~c. The maximum total discount available cannot exceed 25% per class.~~
 - ~~d.c.~~ The classroom monitor’s job will include maintenance of the studio, such as restroom clean-up, vacuuming, and dusting. Cleaning supplies will be provided by the League. The monitor must keep an accurate class attendance and after the final session submit the total attendance to the Class Registrar, Class Coordinator and Treasurer so that the instructor can be paid. A complete list of duties is posted in the Studio and on the League website.
 - ~~e.d.~~ _____ The League charges \$10.00 ~~\$5.00~~ for each class day over and above the instructor’s fee. Non-members will be charged a total of \$15.00 ~~\$10.00~~ for each class day over and above the instructor’s fee.
 - ~~f.e.~~ No refunds will be given to class participants who were not able to attend and did not cancel at least two weeks in advance of the class.
2. Fall Show
 - a. Ballots for the People’s Choice Award at the Fall Show shall be tallied on a day chosen by the show chairs. The number of People’s Choice awards will be decided by the show chairs not to exceed three places (1st, 2nd and 3rd).
 - b. Current officers, followed by committee chairs, will be offered first time sign-up privileges for sitting at the Fall Show each season. The current president and show chairs shall be exempt from the sitting requirements.
 - c. The entry fee for the Fall Show is \$20.00.

~~Donations to the League in the name of an individual will be reserved and awarded to the first place People’s Choice recipient at the Fall Show until the funds are depleted. The distribution of the funds is at the show chair’s discretion not to exceed \$25.00 per award.~~

~~Sale of artwork due to exposure at any League show or exhibit is subject to the League’s commission fee for a one month period after the end of the show.~~

f.d. All entries must be original work (not prints of original work), although photographs and digital art may be prints of the artist's work.

3. Memorial Contributions

- a. In the event of the death of ~~an immediate family member of~~ a League member ~~(husband, wife, children), in lieu of flowers,~~ a \$35.00 contribution will be made to Peters Township Public Library to purchase an art book in their memory. ~~a designated charity.~~

4. Miscellaneous

- a. Any instructor or speaker who earns \$600.00 or above from MAL will have their earnings reported to the IRS. This is required by law.

b. Each artist exhibiting in a League show exempts the League from responsibility for the artist's work.

c. Screens can be rented for \$10 per panel per day, with a \$50 per panel deposit. The renter will be responsible for any damage to the rented screens. The renter will be required to sign a contract with these terms.

d. All displayed ~~art work~~artwork must conform to League standard, except for special exhibits.

~~b-e.~~ Sale of artwork due to exposure at any League show or exhibit is subject to the League's commission for a one-month period after the end of the show.

5. Scholarship

- a. The Bunky Mosites Memorial Scholarship is available to Peters Township High School students and immediate family members of League members. There is one award each spring of \$500.00

6. Spring Show

- a. Prize money for the Spring Show is as follows: First Place: \$100.00 Best of Show is \$200.00 or or the equivalent; Second Place: \$50.00 or the equivalent; Third Place: \$25.00 or the equivalent; and three (3) Honorable Mention ribbons with no monetary award. ~~The show chairs will determine the equivalent prizes. up to 10 Juror's awards, each \$25.00 or the equivalent; Best of Category, each \$50.00 or the equivalent, with "the equivalent" to be determined by show chairs. The Juror has discretion not to award a prize in any given category. Any piece may only receive one award from the Juror.~~

~~The show categories are: Still Life/Floral; Landscape/Seascape; Interior/Exterior/Architecture; Animal/Wildlife; Abstract/Non-Objective; Portrait/Figure; Photography/Digital Art; 3D/Sculpture. The artist chooses which category to assign his/her artwork entered in the show.~~

~~e-b.~~ The entry fee for the Spring Show is \$25.00.

~~d-c.~~ Ballots for the People's Choice Award at the Spring Show shall be tallied on a day chosen by the show chairs. The number of People's Choice awards will be decided by the show chairs not to exceed three places (1st, 2nd and 3rd).

~~e-d.~~ _____ Current officers, followed by current committee chairs, will be offered first time sign-up privileges for sitting at the Spring Show each season. The current president and show chairs shall be exempt from the sitting requirements.

~~f.e. Sale of artwork due to exposure at any League show or exhibit is subject to the League's commission fee for a one-month period after the end of the show.~~

g.f. All entries must be original work (not prints of original work), although photographs and digital art may be prints of the artist's work.

7. Standards

- a. Any work that has been shown in any previous League Spring or Fall Show may not be shown in a current League Spring or Fall Show.
- b. If a piece is rejected from a show, a note to the artist will explain why it was rejected.
